Sometimes we miss a chance to report harassment or assault in a timely way. Sometimes officially reporting feels too costly. Sometimes we just want to know we are not alone, but aren't ready or able to make a full report.

Jennifer Morales invites you to continue the "performance" of unofficial reporting by using the piece of crime scene tape you will find wrapped around this "diploma."

Here is how you can continue this performance over the next days and weeks:

1. If you have been the victim of a crime on or near campus (or know someone who has), please mark the place with this piece of crime scene tape and take a photo.
2. If you have a crime story stuck in your body, you can also take a picture of the piece of crime scene tape on yourself.
3. Upload the photo to your Twitter account and/or other social media. Use the hashtag #PleaseReport. Please tweet it at Jennifer @MoralesWrites and/or post or message me at the "Jennifer Morales, Author" Facebook page.
4. Share the photo with Jennifer at [1jemorales1@gmail.com](mailto:1jemorales1@gmail.com) and indicate in your email whether you are willing to have it posted on the [www.MoralesWrites.com](http://www.MoralesWrites.com) site.
5. If you also want to share a caption, narrative, or other text to accompany your photo on the MoralesWrites website, please indicate in your email if you want to remain totally anonymous, use a pseudonym, or your real name in part or in whole.
6. BE SAFE: This project is an attempt to acknowledge and address ways we have been harmed. You may or may not feel safe participating in this project; please listen to your wisest self and don't do anything to further any injury. If you choose to include yourself in your crime scene photo, I encourage you not to feature your full face.
7. SEEK CAMPUS RESOURCES on sexual assault for yourself and others. Knowledge and community are power.
